

IUPUI Study Abroad Photo Contest Rules and Guidelines

Any student who studied abroad on any approved study abroad program during the past academic year (Fall 2011, Spring 2012 and Summer I and II 2012) is eligible to participate in the contest.

You may submit up to **two** photographs in **each of the four categories listed below** with a **submission form** (next page) for each photo. Photographs should reflect the study abroad experience.

Most Picturesque: Photos depicting beautiful international settings

IUPUI Students Abroad: Photos depicting you or fellow students in a favorite experience abroad

Most Unusual: Photos depicting something unusual encountered while abroad

Cultural Adventures: Photos which illustrate aspects of the host country culture

Photographs must be properly identified with the following:

- Name—Photos must be yours
- Phone/E-mail
- Category
- Location/Country, Program Name, and term attended
- Approximate date photo was taken
- Caption
- Description

Prizes: Last year's prizes included amusement park tickets, a Colts package, gift certificates, and tickets to museums and events. Prizes and awards will be presented at a reception in September 2012.

Contest Judges: Faculty and Staff at IUPUI will judge the photos.

Digital photographs are required and should be sent by attachment to abroad@iupui.edu with at least 300dpi resolution and the required identification information for each photograph.

DEADLINE: All entries must be submitted to the Study Abroad Office (abroad@iupui.edu) by 5:00 pm on Monday, August 13, 2012.

All submissions become the property of the IUPUI Study Abroad Office for use in any future publicity, publications, and/or fundraisers. Photos used in publications may include student's name and program information. If you would prefer that your name not be used, please inform us in writing at the time of submission.

The value of a prize is considered taxable income to the recipient and may require the university to report the value of the prize to federal and state revenue agencies. Indiana University has created a policy to maintain compliance with this IRS Tax law that requires the Office of International Affairs to complete a Prize Tax Data Collection Form and submit it to IU's Financial Management Services Tax Area when winners receive prizes.

By submitting a photo in the contest you acknowledge your understanding of and agreement with the rules and conditions of the contest and subsequent use of your photos to promote study abroad.
